I will read and understand the rules of all of the 4-H projects and Junior Fair exhibits in which I am a participant. I ask that my parents and the supervisor of my 4-H project to be an example of how to accept what life has to offer—good and bad—and how to live with the outcome.

I realize that I am responsible for:

- - understanding and abiding by the Scioto County 4-H Project Requirements, and any Ohio Department of Agriculture and Scioto County Junior Fair Rules that may apply to my project.
- - learning about a project to the best of my ability
- - and the development of sound moral character in myself - - and others.
