

FAIR 4-H BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT

All displays must have the club's name visibly posted. Displays must be cared for and kept in an attractive manner by the club during the fair. Items must be registered in the 4-H building by Monday 12:00 noon of the fair and removed during designated booth tear down times.

4 CLASSES:

- 1- Small flower pots, baskets, boxes or other containers
(2 minimum)
- 2- Large flower pots, baskets, boxes or other containers
(2 minimum)
- 3- Hanging baskets
(2 minimum)

Classes 1, 2 and 3 above will receive premiums on 1st thru 4th place as follows: \$10, \$8, \$6 and \$4.

- 4- Large ground displays
(must be approved by Extension Agent and/or Senior Fair Board)

Class 4 Premiums =	1st	-	\$25
	2nd	-	\$20
	3rd	-	\$18
	4th	-	\$15

AWARDS

Awards will be given for 1 - 5 placings in each category. Places 1 - 5 will receive ribbons. Places 1 - 4 will receive premium.
