SENIOR

1. Any 4-H member who has not participated in the National 4-H Horse Judging Contest in Louisville, Kentucky shall be eligible to participate. Each county may enter up to **eight individuals (2 teams)**. When four members judge as a team, the contestant with the lowest overall score will be designated as the alternate, but will be eligible for individual awards. If a county does not have enough members for a team (minimum of three), then they may enter one or two individuals to compete for high individual.
2. Contestants must have passed their 14th birthday, and must not have passed their 19th birthday on January 1 of the current year. No Junior age youth are permitted in the Senior Age Division.
3. Contestants will be required to judge halter and performance classes. Two to three sets of oral reasons will also be required. Notes are not permitted while giving oral reasons.

JUNIOR

1. Each county may enter up to eight individuals (2 teams). Participants must be 4-H members who are 13 years of age or under as of January 1 of the current year.
2. Contestants will place the same classes as senior contestants, but are not required to give oral reasons.

AWARDS

SENIOR

1. Awards for the five top scoring county teams of three or four members and the top ten individuals will be provided by the **Ohio State Fair**.
2. Awards for the top 10 highest scoring individuals in ORAL REASONS will be provided by **Franklin County Farm Bureau**.
3. The winning county team will represent Ohio at the Eastern National 4-H Horse Judging Contest, and one or two other regional or breed contests. The second place county team will represent Ohio at two contests not entered by the winning team or in contests that allow two state 4-H teams to participate. The Extension Horse Specialist and the State 4-H Office will notify the teams as to which contests to enter.
4. If, because of illness, school conflicts, etc., a coach of a winning team needs additional youth to create a team of four to represent Ohio, they may invite any individual placing in the top twenty at the state contest to fill their team.
5. The Ohio State Fair provides some financial aid to the champion Senior team to compete in regional and the Eastern National 4-H Roundup.

JUNIOR

1. Rosettes provided by the **Ohio State Fair** will be presented to the top five teams and top ten individuals.
2. A special participation ribbon will be provided to Junior Contestants who give a set of reasons during the 220 Oral Reasons workshop. The ribbons will be provided by the **Franklin County Farm Bureau**.
