Additional Fees: \$5.00 ground fee per horse will apply or stalls rentals will be available for \$25.00.

Shavings not provided and stalls must be stripped upon exit.

Camping: Available Friday to Saturday

\$35 per day for electric and water;

\$15 per day for primitive camping.

- ❖ After entries have been received, classes will possibly be split by Junior and Senior Divisions depending on the number of entries for each class.
- ❖ All ponies will need be measured at the registration building/announcer stand on the right side of the arena.
- ❖ Tack and equipment check will be made by the judge prior to exhibition.
- ❖ Coggins test will be required for State Fair Exhibition.
