



Scioto County Fair Beautification Project

RULES: All displays must have the club's name visibly posted. Displays must be cared for and kept in an attractive manner by the club during the fair. Items must be registered in the 4-H building by noon Monday of the fair and removed during designated booth tear down times.

CLASSES:

- 1 Small Flower Pots, baskets, boxes or other containers
(2 minimum)
- 2 Large Flower Pots, baskets, boxes or other containers
(2 minimum)
- 3 Hanging Baskets
(2 minimum)

Classes 1, 2 and 3 will receive premiums on first through fourth place as follows: \$10, \$8, \$6 and \$4.

- 4 Large Ground Displays
(must be approved by Extension Educators and/or Sr. Fair Board)

Class 4 premiums will be awarded as follows: 1st - \$25, 2nd - \$20, 3rd - \$18, and 4th - \$15.

Entries will be judged on the following criteria: Creativity, Quality and Visibility of Club Name.

Award ribbons will be given for the top five placings. Premiums will be awarded to the top four places.
