Scioto 4-H equine members may enroll in as many 4-H equine projects as they feel they can successfully complete; however, members may only exhibit up to two equine animals and up to two production animals (one mare and foal and/or one yearling) during the junior fair assuming the space is available.

****Please initial next to each bullet below to acknowledge you have read and understand each guideline.**

- Members must enroll in the same number of equine projects (or more) as the number of horses they register.
- Any 4-H member who plans on participating in any jumping activities for jumping classes must be currently enrolled in project #180, Learning to Jump.
- Any 4-H member who plans on participating in any gymkhana activities for gymkhana classes (barrels, poles, stakes, etc.) must be currently enrolled in project #186, Gymkhana.
- Any 4-H member who plans on participating in the Ground Roping class must be currently enrolled in project #187, Roping.
- Members involved in driving must enroll in the following projects depending on their horse and interests: #175 Light Horse Selection, #181 Draft Horse, or #184 Standardbred Horses.
- Members exhibiting miniature horses that are exhibited in harnesses must enroll in project #182 Small Equine, for driving information contained in the project book.
- An equine production project is considered either a mare and foal or yearling (1 year old). Depending on the age and training needs of the foal, members should enroll these projects in either #185 Equine Reproduction or #177 Horse Training.

NOTE: Current photocopies of animal should be submitted with this form to complete identification.

Identification cannot be accepted without proper photocopies.

Photos should include: 1) Left side of animal 2) Right side of animal 3) Front of animal 4) Back of animal.

Only the horse/pony being identified should be included in the photos (please no exhibitors, animals, saddles, etc.).
