RE: Upcoming Project Judging

Please read the information on the back of this letter very carefully. It contains a complete judging schedule and important reminders for 2018 Food and Clothing judging days.

Clothing and Quilting project judging will begin at **10 a.m.**, Wednesday, July 18th, at Valley Middle School. The Style Review and awards program for Clothing will be the next evening, July 19th at 5:30 p.m. (Modeling practice will be at 4:30 p.m. and line-up at 5 p.m.) Please be there and in line at 5 p.m. Quilting projects can be modeled on the stage during the style review as well.

Still Project judging will be held at **3 p.m.**, Wednesday, July 18, at the Middle School. The awards program for still projects will be Thursday July 19th following the style review at 7 p.m.

Food Projects and Cake Decorating will be judged at **11 a.m.**, Thursday, July 19, at the Valley Middle School. Awards will be given that evening after the clothing style review at 7 p.m. Please be sure to bring all the required items to your judging. The requirements are listed on the back of this letter.

Also, note that the Ohio State Fair Food and Nutrition Judging now requires a scrapbook/notebook to go along with your project, so you may want to begin working on that prior to county judging. Tips to complete this notebook are available on the state 4-H Web site. Additionally, MyPlate knowledge is required for 4-H members at project judging this year with their food projects.

This year we will also be holding our Kids College on July 12th at the SOMC Friends Center from 6-8 p.m.. This event is to give 4-H members will have the opportunity to learn more about what is expected for judging at the county and state level for their projects and to help answer any questions that you might have prior to county judging.
