- _____ • Members involved in driving must enroll in the following project books depending on their horse and interests: #175 Light Horse Selection, #181 Draft Horse, or #184 Standardbred Horses.
- _____ • Members exhibiting miniature horses that are exhibited in harness must enroll in project #182, Small Equine, for the driving information contained in this project book.
- _____ • Members who are interested in competing at the State Competitive Trail Ride, which is held in September, must be enrolled in #188 Trail Riding
