

COUNTY FAIR 4-H HORSE SHOW

REFER TO JR. FAIR SCHEDULE FOR TIME AND DATE

1. 4-H members participating in the County Fair Show must follow the Scioto County 4-H Horse Project Requirements along with the Uniform Rules for 4-H Horse Shows, revised 2000, stated in the General Rules.
2. 4-H members must complete class entry forms and return them by the designated date.
3. Each year the winner of the designated Senior Showmanship class will show in the Showman of Showmen contest, Friday, of the fair, 6:00 p.m., at the Show Arena. The first place participant of the Senior Showmanship Class on Wednesday, of the fair, will compete in the Showman of Showmen contest (i.e. alternating English and Western). **The winner must show his/her own horse.**
4. Classes will be determined by the style of riding and age of exhibitor according to the horse identification forms and lease agreements, which must be received by May 1.
5. Members will only be permitted to participate in four classes per project at the County Fair Horse Show. (This does not include Production Classes).
6. Classes will be divided according to Scioto County 4-H standard age divisions (Jr. 9-11; Inter. 12-14; Sr. 15-18) and at the discretion of the Horse Committee in the interest of time and safety. Some classes may be combined due to number of participants. If classes are too large, a split will be made with the top placing individuals competing in an overall class for ribbons and awards.
