

# SPECIAL LIVESTOCK PROJECT HOUSING AGREEMENTS

Any youth participating in the Scioto County 4-H Program must have their animal in their possession and continual care by May 1 (or the date specified in that project's specific guidelines).

Animals should be housed at the youth's residence to facilitate the proper care of the animal(s). However, in limited and approved instances a 4-H'er may house their project animal somewhere other than their residence. Any such instances must be submitted (in writing) for approval according to Scioto County 4-H program guidelines.

The following is a list of terms that need to be submitted in writing to the Extension Office by May 1 of the current 4-H year.

- 4-H'ers name, address, club and dated signature
- Parents (or guardians) name, and dated signature
- Name, address and phone number of person (or place) who is housing animal, and dated signature
- Specific arrangements for animal
- Type of animal, breed, identification number, color, etc.

## EXAMPLE:

Joe Farmer will provide stall and pasture space for Susie 4-H'ers black and white hampshire market hog #444 for the 2010 4-H year. Susie agrees to continually feed and care for the animal housed at 000 Farmer Lane, 4-Hville, Ohio.
