The Scioto County Junior Fair Market Animal Exhibitors are required to complete the survey at the link above to submit their information for the 2021 Online Livestock Sale. The information that is submitted will be utilized to create a profile for each exhibitor where buyers will be able to place their bids.

Information will also be submitted for the destination of the animal. For Local Market processing: Sheep, Goats and Steers will have the option to be sent on a truck to the stockyards where the exhibitors will receive the current market price. Hogs, the large processors have declined to bid this year. We have been in contact with the local processors (Chase N Cattle, The Local Butcher, and Garrisons) and they are holding slots open for us so you (or a buyer of your choice) can have your market animal processed. The sale committee is planning to have trucks available to transport animals Saturday evening, August 14<sup>th</sup>. Market animals will NOT have the option to take their animals home and be able to go through the sale for 2021. Rabbits and Chickens will have a truck available to take their animals.
